SAXIFRAGACEAE OF TAIWAN

It is more than twenty five years since Masamune's Short Flora of Formosana was published in 1936. After that date the work on the taxonomy of the Taiwan plants was largely discontinued for about ten years owing to the War. However during the past decade, revisional studies of the flora have been greatly accelerated by the Taiwan botanists, though a complete new flora is still far from completion. A preparation of a new flora is indeed an urgent need not only for the biologists of Taiwan but for botanists in many other countries as well.

During the school year 1960-1961 the first named author had the privilege of working at the National Taiwan University and together with the second named author made a number of collecting trips in various parts of Taiwan. In the course of the examination of some thousands of specimens acquired on these trips we sometimes have met with new or interesting species. In this and following papers, we intend to present some results of our taxonomic studies. Our design is to revise each family or genus, and thus aid in gathering materials for a new flora of Taiwan.

The present paper is a critical revision of Saxifragaceae of Taiwan, we recognize 12 genera and 23 subgeneric taxa. No new species are described but considerable new information regarding the plants and their distribution has been included. The keys will serve for determination of any Saxifragaceous plants of Taiwan.

In this paper the following abbreviations are used to indicate the herbaria in which the specimens cited are preserved.

Basing upon difference of only number of stamens, McClintock reduced H. petiolaris

to a subspecific rank of *H. anomala* and published her opinion that the Taiwan plant so far called *H. anomala* was same with *H. petiolaris* of Japan. The result of our examination, however, is that the Japanese plant has about 20 stamens 3–5 mm long while the Taiwan plant 10 or so stamens only 1–3 mm long. In this respect, we prefer to assign the Taiwan plant to the continental *H. anomala* as done by some previous authors.

McClintock considered *H. longifolia* of Taiwan as same with *H. involucrata* of Japan. Comparing these two species, leaves of the former are constantly oblong adpressedly serrated and shorter petioles 1–2 cm long. Contrariwise, those of the latter are widely ovate with triangular teeth at the margins and longer petioles extending 8 cm long. The floral parts of the former, in addition, are distinctly larger than those of the latter. This is the reason why we prefer to separate the Taiwan plant from the Japanese one.
