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Cover Photo: A new species of clear-winged moth, *Corematosetia parvimaculata* Liang & Hsu, 2023, was found from stems of *Ardisia sieboldii* Miq. and *A. quinquegona* Blume (Primulaceae), which are trees common throughout lowland of southern China. The larva bores into the stem of the hostplants, often causing terminal buds to wither. The photograph shows a freshly male adult of this moth just emerged from a stem of *A. sieboldii*.

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
